Subject: Compliance with break period
of the school year calendar.

In previous school years, I repeatedly noted a lack of awareness and poor implementation of the regulations setting out the school year calendar and the periods during which lessons are not held in schools.

For example, some heads of private secular and denominational schools set the dates for the submission of reports, holidays and the resumption of lessons in their schools, according to their own interests and on the grounds of supposed internal organisation, thereby seriously breaking these provisions.

With regard to the current school year, and in order to put an end to these shortcomings, which are highly detrimental to the quality of the education system in our region.

I would like to remind you of the provisions of Article 4 paragraph 1 of Joint Decree N° 60/B1/1464/ AC/MINEDUB/MINESEC of 06 August 2024 to fix the calendar for the 2024/2025 school year in the Republic of Cameroon which stipulates the following:

The periods during which the classes are not held are defined as follows:

- 1st break: from Friday 20 December 2024 at 3.30 p.m. To Monday 06 January 2025 at 7.30 a.m.
- 2nd break: From Friday 4 April 2024 at 3.30 p.m. to Tuesday 22 April at 7.30 a.m."

No school is authorised to receive students for teaching purposes during this period.
I hold you in high esteem for the faultless application of my present instructions.
